**ORDER**

In continuation of earlier Government order vide No. HLA.270/2020/165, Dated 22<sup>nd</sup> April, 2020 facilitating stranded persons to travel from one location to another location within the State, the following additional guidelines are issued for clarity of all concerned:

- I) Though no one is allowed to go out of the districts of Goalpara, Nalbari, Morigaon, Golaghat and Dhubri, persons from other districts may be allowed to come to these districts.
- II) The pick-up and drop-off points in each district are to be decided by MD, ASTC in consultation with respective Deputy Commissioners.
- iii) The Deputy Commissioners of originating and the destination districts should arrange medical screening of persons at both the places and take necessary action for keeping people in facility/ home quarantine or otherwise, as per extant guidelines.
