

Report on Cluster Containment of Spanish Garden, Guwahati District Administration Kamrup (Metropolitan)

1. **4- April-2020** : Order Passed for sealing (cluster containment) Spanish Garden Apartment – communication sent to all stakeholders ([Annexure 1](#))
2. This was necessitated with a resident of said apartment having tested positive for COVID-19.
3. The following actions were taken
 - A. Travel History for patient ascertained prior to test.
 - B. Contact Tracing – family members, household help, employees, friends etc
 - C. Complete Medical History of patient recorded
 - D. Complete movement history ascertained for extensive contact tracing ([Refer Annexure 2](#))

4. All probable suspects from Contact tracing (68 individuals in the district, 16 in other districts & 1 from Shillong, Meghalaya). Individuals identified within the district into a Quarantine facility @ TB Hospital, Birubari, Guwahati). **Besides individually contacting all traced individuals**, social networking was used wherein patient appealed to all friends and acquaintances, who may have come in contact with him in the past 2 weeks to identify themselves – this was further done by the individuals identified to encompass the entire contact tracing ([Refer Annexure 2](#))

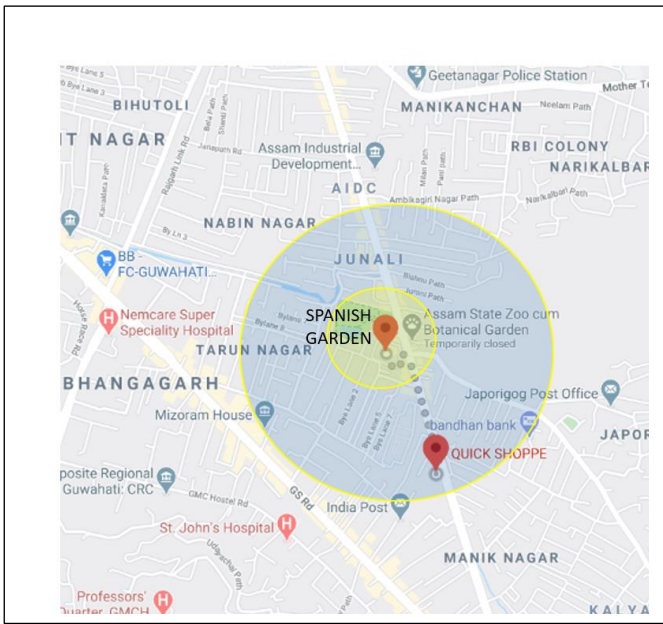
An intensive **Risk communication** was done with the residents of Spanish Garden and counselling done for a smooth, peaceful implementation of Cluster containment – Society office bearers & other Influencers were used to propagate the communication further.

5. For supply of Essential Commodities
 - A. A Fair price shop & 3 other establishments were identified, contacted within the vicinity and asked /allowed to deliver essentials including vegetables, grocery, baby-food & other essential commodities – for requirements received online/telephonically – Order issued from District Administration on 5th April 2020 – in less than 24 hours. ([Refer Annexure 3 & 4](#))
 - B. A medicine supplier was identified for Home delivery of all medicines & other medical supplies for the residents of Spanish Garden.

Extensive communication within the community was done for the awareness of all residents

6. All residents are under close supervision for symptoms of Covid-19, as a surveillance measure in containment zone
7. Entire Apartment & vicinity has been thoroughly sanitized/sprayed on 4th April & 5th April.
8. All shops & commercial establishments within a 1 Km radius has been ordered closed for containment , deemed as a buffer zone.
9. Quick Shoppe – a high traffic supermarket, where patient had visited was also ordered shut and sanitized
10. Perimeter Control has been done with check posts being set up on all roads leading to Spanish Garden

ORDER

In view of the detection of COVID-19 positive patient namely SHRI MANISH TIBREWAL, a resident of **FLAT NO. 704, BLOCK-D, SPANISH GARDEN, R.G.BARUAH ROAD, GUWAHATI**, in the interest of maintenance of public hygiene it is felt necessary to immediately seal the area/campus of **SPANISH GARDEN APARTMENT, R.G.BARUAH ROAD, GUWAHATI** to arrest the spread of COVID-19.

Any unauthorized entry and exit into the Spanish Garden is barred till the area is completely surveyed and sanitized by the Health Authority.

Any movement of any vehicles is also prohibited with immediate effect.

All statutory and other directions regarding maintenance of social distancing will be strictly enforced in the sealed area.

This order is made under the regulations "The Assam COVID-19 Regulations, 2020" and shall be effective from 10-00 AM of 4th April' 2020 until further order.

Any violation of this order will attract action under the provisions of "The Assam COVID-19 Regulations, 2020" "The Disaster Management Act-2005", The Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897 and other relevant laws of the nation.

Manish Tibrewal went to Delhi with his family on 27-02-2020. They attended a workshop ACREX Conference where international traveller were present in Greater Noida on 27th and 28th Feb'20. They visited agra Tazmahal and Brindaban also. They came back to Guwahati on 01-03-2020 by Air Asia flight at 6:30 PM.

1. On 6th March he visited Mr. Charles Pyngron at Shilong and returned same day.
2. Around 8th March he visited Dr. Kamal Jain at Arya Hospital due to some difficulty in breathing. There was no fever as he was an Asthmatic patient so he was medicated as earlier with nebulisation.
3. Around 10th March he visited Midland hospital for some complain where he was nebulised with Oxygen in emergency room. On the same day he socialized with Mr. Sekhar Goenka and his family(now at Dibrugarh) and Ritesh Agarwal(Spenish Garden) in Holly Party.
4. On 11th March he visited Apollo hospital where there were 17 persons of the hospital staff
5. On 17th he visited Dr. Kripesh Sarma at Apollo hospital. There was another 4 hospital staff.
6. On 18th or 19th March he met electrical contractor Mohibul Rahman .
7. On 19th March he visited Health City Hospital along with his 2 relatives and Dr. Abhinash khedria in same vehicle. At night he was present in the party organized by Dr. Lalit Shah at Hotel Nandan where he met around another 10 persons.
8. On 24-03-2020 he has developed fever with difficulty on breathing. Same day he visited Dentist Dr. Subhankar Das,
9. On 26th March onwards he was under self quarantine after visiting Dr. Abhishek Agarwal at Dispur hospital where CT Scan was done where he contacted around 5 persons. There was Headache fever and mild Diarrhoea from the same day.
10. On 28th March Mr. Ramesh Bori, Technician of Apollo Clinic,Ulubari visited for Blood sample.
 11. On 2nd April he was informed by Dr. Abhishek Agarwal that he has suggestive finding of COVID19 in his Radio Graph. Then he visited GMCH and gave is sample for COVID19 testing.
 12. On 3rd March he was declared positive for COVID19 and same day he was shifted to GMCH Isolation ward where he is under treatment till now. His condition is stable so far.
 - i. Around **85** nos of contact tracing has been done so far out of which **68** persons were from Kamrup Metro, 16 from other district and 1 from Shilong.
 - ii. Till date **65** samples has been collected. Out of which 61 from Kamrup Metro, 1 from Shilng,2 from Dibrugarh,1 from Darrang
 - iii. His 3 family members are in Home Quarantine at Spenish Garden as directed by Health Ministry. Other contacts are at TB Hospital new building Kalapahar.
